Academic Preparation and Placement Program (APP) Domestic Admit Types June 2017

The mandatory APP is designed for all <u>new, first-time</u> UK students. "First-time" is defined by the Council on Post-Secondary Education (CPE) as:

- First-time in college
- First-time transfers in college

Please consult the list below for how various domestic (U.S.) admit types are viewed with regard to the mandatory APP.

New freshmen: Mandatory APP

All new freshmen who score within mandatory APP range must take the appropriate APP course.

Transfer students: Mandatory APP (situation-specific)*

TR-Transfer from another institution with 24 or more hours TX-Freshman Transfer with 23 or fewer hours

English/Writing:

<u>TR</u>: If the student has 3 hours of transfer credit for ENG 101, ENG 102, ENG 104 , CIS 110/111 or WRD 110/11, they have satisfied the college readiness requirement.

If not, the student must either complete UK 130 – APP Writing, submit exam (ACT/SAT, etc.) scores, or complete the placement exam.

<u>TX</u>: If the student has 3 hours of transfer credit for **ENG 101, ENG 102, ENG 104 , CIS 110/111 or WRD 110/11**, they have satisfied the college readiness requirement.

If not, the student must either complete UK 130 – APP Writing, submit exam (ACT/SAT, etc.) scores, or complete the placement exam.

Math:

<u>TR</u>: If the student has any transfer work that has a class of **MA 1xx** (100-level MA class) or higher, they have satisfied the college readiness requirement.

If not, they must either complete UK 095 – APP Math for Quantitative Reasoning or UK 096 – APP Math for College Algebra, submit exam (ACT/SAT, etc.) scores, or complete the placement exam.

<u>TX</u>: If the student has any transfer work that has a class of **MA 1xx** (100-level MA class) or higher, they have satisfied the college readiness requirement.

If not, they must either complete UK 095 – APP Math for Quantitative Reasoning or UK 096 – APP Math for College Algebra, submit exam (ACT/SAT, etc.) scores, or complete the placement exam.

Reading:

<u>TR</u>: If the student has completed 24 college-level credit hours at a 2.0 GPA or better, they have satisfied the college readiness requirement.

If not, the student must either complete UK 120 – APP Reading, submit exam (ACT/SAT, etc.) scores, or complete the placement exam.

<u>TX</u>: If the student has completed fewer than 24 college-level credit hours, or have below a 2.0 GPA or better, the student must either complete UK 120 – APP Reading, submit exam (ACT/SAT, etc.) scores, or complete the placement exam.

<u>*At a See Blue U orientation</u>: If the transfer student's advisor does not know all the courses a student brings with him/her, the advisor should review the student's schedule again once transfer courses are recorded to ensure proper course placement.

Re-admitted students: Mandatory APP (situation-specific)

English/Writing: Readmits who score within mandatory APP range and have not completed a freshman English course must take the UK 130 - APP Writing.

Math: Readmits who score within mandatory APP range and have not completed a credit-bearing math course must take UK 095 – APP Math for Quantitative Reasoning, UK 096 – APP Math for College Algebra, or take MA 108R at another institution.

Reading: Readmits who score within mandatory APP range and have not earned a 2.0 full-time semester GPA (Reading) must take UK 120 – APP Reading.

Non-degree students: Optional APP

Non-degree students may take APP courses at their discretion.
