Responsibilities will include:

- Field data collection
- Harvesting plants
- Preparing and analyzing seeds for future studies
- Occasional greenhouse work or sample preparation for laboratory analysis.

Requirements:

- No experience required!
- Students must be eligible to be authorized to drive a university vehicle for travel to research farms.
- This position requires outdoor work in all weather, and will include lifting, walking on uneven ground, and working in proximity to agricultural equipment.

All safety and research trainings will be provided on the job. Wage will align with CAFE standards.
