Applicants must have demonstrated outstanding leadership skills and have significantly contributed to either the university or the local community.

Applicants must have a strong academic record as evidenced by the student's coursework and GPA. Applicants should have a **minimum** GPA of 3.3.

Applicants must be full-time students at the University of Kentucky (during the 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 academic years) and be enrolled in any undergraduate or graduate/professional program

Following an initial review of the applications, we will request 20-minute interviews from selected candidates. The tentative interview date is Saturday, **February 10, 2018**.

Scholarship recipients will be asked to attend a scholarship banquet in the spring semester and attend a luncheon in the fall semester to meet and thank our scholarship donors.

2. Please submit an unofficial copy of all undergraduate and/or graduate **transcripts** (available online through myUK). **Freshmen that are applying can submit transcripts from their first semester on February 10, 2018 if they are asked back for an interview.**
3. Please include a **resume** including your *collegiate* work experience, community service, scholarships/honors/awards, and other pertinent information.
4. Please submit your answer to the one of the following essay questions below. Responses should be typed, double spaced, and limited to fewer than 500 words.
  - If you had \$1,000 to give to UK, where would you give it? Why?
  - During your time at UK, how have you helped to promote a culture of philanthropy on campus?
